# File Upload Tab

This guide instructs the Site Admins on how to perform the Hip & Knee Assessment file upload.

## Step 1: File Upload Template

1. Click on the **File Upload** menu.
2. Click on **File Template** tab.
3. Select the **“Hip & Knee Screening Assessment – RCC”** template from the **Template Name** dropdown.



4. Click on **Download**.
5. Downloaded template is in CSV file format. Refer to **Appendix: Patient Template Data Elements** and **Score Legends**.

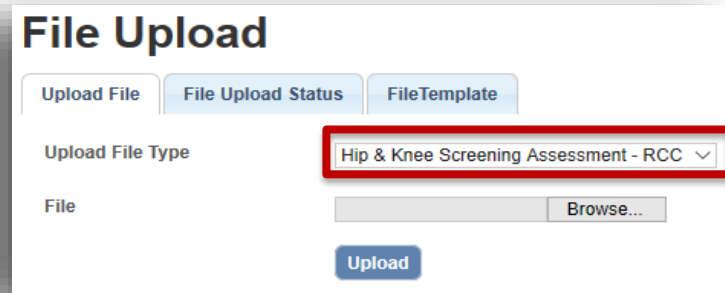
**Note:** In case notepad is being used to update the data in the csv file ensure mentioning values in commas e.g. “0, 1, 3, 4”

## Step 2: Upload File

To upload a completed file template:

1. Click on the **File Upload** menu. (The **Upload File** tab is the default.)
2. Select **Upload File Type** as “**Hip & Knee Screening Assessment – RCC**” from the dropdown.
3. Browse for file and click on **Upload**. User will automatically be moved to the File Upload Status tab.

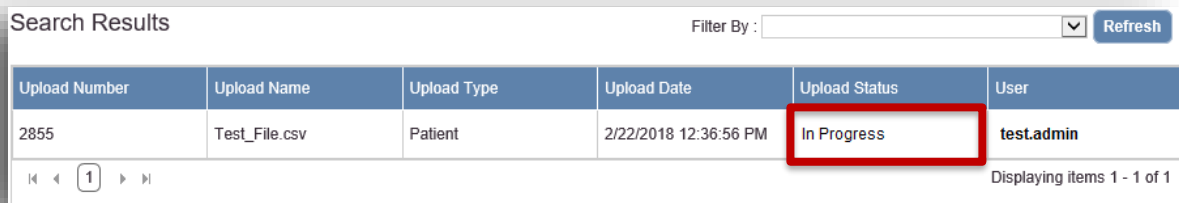

## Step 3: Check File Upload Status

The File Upload Status tab can be used to view the status of the File Upload or to search File Upload history.

1. While file upload is being processed, the user will automatically be moved from the Upload File tab to the **File Upload Status** tab.
2. During upload, the Upload Status in the Search Results grid will read **In Progress**. Click the **Refresh** button to update the status.

## Step 4: Validate Patient Data Update

3. Click **View** under **Survey Results**

### File Upload Template Data Elements

Data Element	Definition	Format	Valid Values
* Medical Record Number	Patient identifier code that is unique within the healthcare facility.	CHAR 10 Alpha-numeric.	Consistent with CIHI NACRS and DAD definition and format.
* Health Card Number	Patient's most recent health insurance number assigned by their provincial government of residence.	CHAR 10 Alpha-numeric.	The following values are only to be used when unable to provide a Health Card Number.  0-insured resident of reporting province, but HCN not available.  1=not applicable, includes: out of province resident with unavailable HCN, Out of Country, no health insurance coverage from province of residence.
*Assessment Date	The date of the Assessment was attempted	YYYYMMDD	Valid dates only.
* Laterality 0-RHip, 1-LHip, 3-RKnee, 4-LKnee	Patient selected body part during the assessment	String	Valid Values : 0,1,3,4 For excel data entry, ensure that the values are separated by comma within the column. Spacing is crucial, there should be no spacing between the comma and digits – else the file will not upload successfully. In case notepad is being used to update the data in the csv file ensure mentioning values in commas e.g. "0,1,3,4 "
