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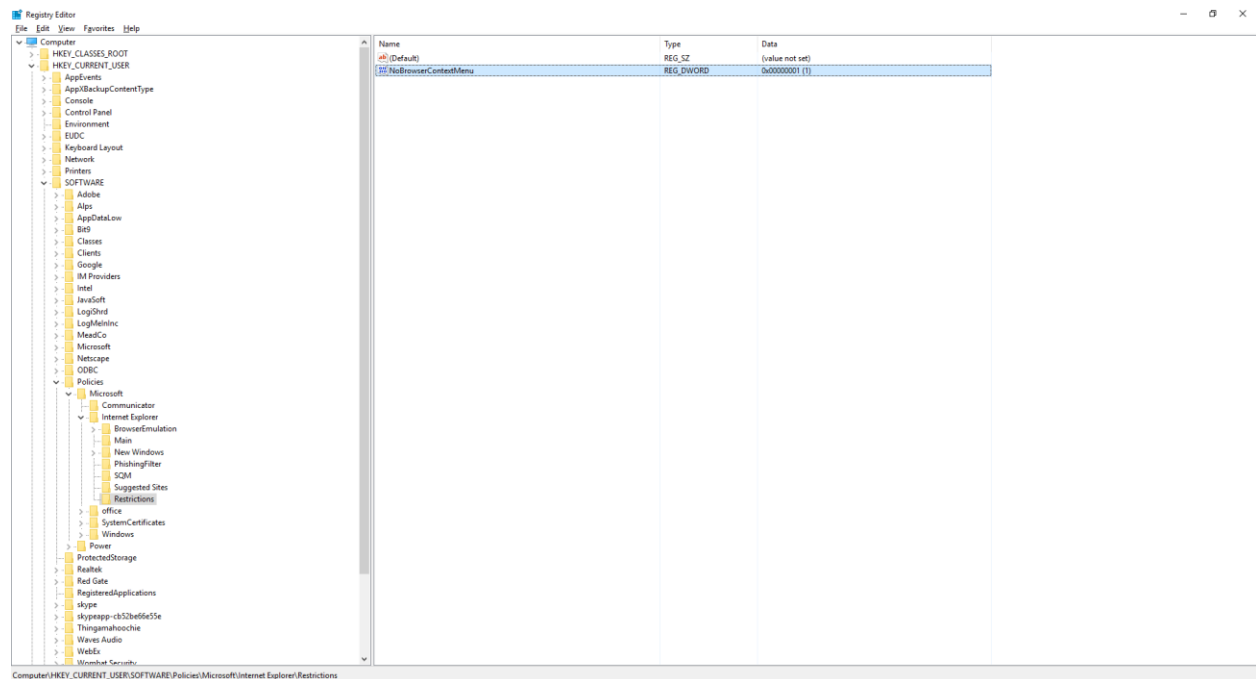
ISAAC Recommendations

Lockdown a Kiosk Machine

The following steps are a few recommendations on how to lockdown a kiosk machine based on a Windows 10 operating system.

After installing Windows and following the ISAAC site and kiosk configuration:

- Make sure a kiosk user with local admin has been created (required to install **ActiveX control** used in automatic printing and update registry entries)
 - Make sure the password is set to not expire and cannot be changed
- Sign in with the kiosk user
- Run **regedit.exe**
- Change registry entry to disable right click for Internet Explorer (if it does not exist, add it)
 - HKEY_CURRENT_USER\Software\Policies\Microsoft\Internet Explorer\Restrictions
 - In the right pane, add/update the DWORD NoBrowserContextMenu and set it to 1.



- Add to: **C:\Users\kioskuser\AppData\Roaming\Microsoft\Windows\Start Menu\Programs\Startup**

a batch file with the following commands:

```
rem stop explorer to disable any user interaction
taskkill /F /IM explorer.exe

rem start internet explorer in kiosk mode
"c:\program files(x86)\Internet Explorer\iexplorer.exe" -k

ISAAC_STARTUP.BAT

- Enable auto login for the kiosk user
 - Press **Windows Key + R** or launch Run from your start menu.
 - In the Run command box, type **netplwiz** and press Enter to open the User Accounts panel.
 - In the Users tab, uncheck this checkbox: “Users must enter a username and a password to use this computer” and then click Ok.
 - Enter username and password to use for auto login
 - Reboot

To Restore Explorer on the Kiosk

- Press CTRL + ALT + DELETE
- Start new task
- Type explorer.exe

To Disable Auto Login

- Press **Windows Key + R**, type **netplwiz** and press Enter to open the User Accounts panel.
- Check the “Users must enter a username and password to use this computer” option and click Apply.
- Restart your computer and the system will prompt you to enter your password at the **login** screen.
